AGM NOTICE

It is time once again for us all to consider the office-bearer and committee positions for our Art Society. The positions for the financial year 2024/25 will be decided at our upcoming **AGM at** 12 midday Sunday 21st July, 2024 in the Goulburn Workers Club. Any organisation is best served when responsibility is shared and does not fall on the same people year after year. With that in mind, I encourage you to nominate or think about whom you would like to nominate for the positions listed on the front page of this newsletter.

Most positions are self-explanatory; however, an explanation of Committee Members might be helpful. It is a GDAS constitutional requirement to choose a Committee of 7 people out of which a quorum of 5 make organisational decisions. 4 of those Committee Members are required to be the President, the Vice President, the Secretary and the Treasurer. Therefore only 3 extra members are needed to make up the 7. When nominating Committee Members, being mindful of the important function they hold, please choose people who are willing to attend meetings regularly.

Please also note that our current Vice President and Workshop Coordinator, Susan Harris, will not be recontesting these or any other positions.

Extract from our Constitution:

- 14 Composition of committee
- (1) The committee must have 7 members, as elected in accordance with clause 15, consisting of:
 - (a) the following office-bearers:
 - the president, (i)
 - (ii) the vice-president,
 - (iii) the secretary,
 - (iv) the treasurer, and
- (b) at least 3 ordinary committee members. Note - The Act, section 28 contains requirements relating to membership eligibility and composition of the committee.
- (2) An office-bearer may hold up to 2 offices, other than both the offices of president and vicepresident.

NOTICE OF MOTION

Notice is hereby given that the next meeting of GDAS will be held at 10am on Thursday, June 13th, 2024, at The Art Studio, 2 Bourke St, Goulburn.

Please note that at today's meeting (May 9th, 2024), it was proposed to increase our membership fees by \$10.00/year from \$30.00 to \$40.00.

Members should be aware that membership fees have not risen for many years. As a result of rising CPI and to bring us into line with similar Art Societies in this region, it was proposed to make this small increase.

As a consequence, a formal motion will be put at the June meeting as follows:

"That the membership fees of GDAS be increased to \$40.00 per annum from July 1, 2024"

As everybody knows, membership fees for each financial year are due prior to commencement of that financial year. If the motion passes, \$40.00 will be due by each member prior to June 30th, 2024.



MICHELANGELO'S TENDER FRIENDSHIP WITH RENAISSANCE POET VITTORIA **COLONNA (1492-1547)**

Until the late 19th century, rumor had it that an Italian woman named Vittoria Colonna had served as Michelangelo's muse. They'd been involved in a passionate affair, the story went, and he'd written the love poetry to prove it. Scholars gradually began to untangle the myth and, in 1893, British Michelangelo biographer John Addington Symonds set the record straight. "The world seems unable to take interest in a man unless it can contrive to discover a love-affair in his career," he chided. "Romancers and legend-makers have, therefore, forced Vittoria Colonna to play the role of Juliet in Michelangelo's life drama.'

[...] For her part, Colonna impacted Michelangelo's life in far more significant ways than sitting for a portrait or sharing his bed. A celebrated poet, she influenced his ideas about religion, patronized his work, and served as one of his closest confidantes.
